The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 2, 2010 at 6 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Tyson Haynes presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyson Haynes, Aldermen: Wayne Graves, Celeste Martin, Gary Brock and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Haynes called the meeting to order presenting the agenda for review and approval.

Gary, "I make a motion we approve the agenda." Fred seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

MINUTES: Mayor Haynes presented the minutes of last month for review and adoption.

Gary, "I make a motion we adopt the minutes as presented." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Haynes called for Franks Adams, director of Keep Chatsworth Murray Beautiful, to make his presentation to Zaxby's.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**FINANCE:** Councilman Graves advised that revenues are down 15% this year. We are working on 2011 budget reduction with no capital expenditures.

**INFRASTRUCTURE:** Councilman Brock advised that collections were heavy this month. Also the new mower was received, and sidewalk repairs have begun. The water department is considering the installation of special meters for irrigation. If this is something you are interested in it would be recommended that you express your interest to the water department.

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY:** Councilwoman Martin made the presentation of an amended "Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance" for first reading. She called for Ms. Flood to highlight the presentation.

Ms. Flood advised this was a model ordinance and was necessary to update the FEMA maps which are to be effective on September 29, 2010.

Mayor Haynes called for a motion to adopt the proposed ordinance as presented as the first reading.

Councilwoman Martin, "I make a motion we adopt this as the first reading." Fred seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:** Councilman Welch asked for a report from Chief Baxter.

Mr. Baxter expressed it had been a quiet month. Two part time firefighters had become certified in hazardous materials, Jeremy Baird and Jordan Parker.

Chief Martin advised they had 1027 dispatches this month. He had been discussing an amnesty day with probate court and Eton during which the bench warrant fees would be waived with fine payment.

Discussion followed with Councilman Welch, "I move we allow the Chief to coordinate this for a one week period." Wayne seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Attorney Williams clarified that a bondsman must be notified with 120 to 150 days allowed prior to the final appearance hearing.

Marshal Smith advised he had completed his training this month.

Mayor Haynes adjourned the meeting at 6:30 p.m.

**A RESOLUTION TO TRANSMIT**

**WHEREAS,** The Georgia Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Act requires county and municipal governments to prepare a local solid waste management plan and periodic updates; and

**WHEREAS,** Chatsworth, Georgia has completed a Five-Year Update to the Joint Solid Waste Management Plan for Murray County and the Cities of Chatsworth and Eton, 2005-2014; and

**WHEREAS,** Chatsworth, Georgia has complied with the Rules of the Georgia Department of Community Affairs Minimum Planning Standards and Procedures for Solid Waste Management for public participation, including the initial joint public meeting held June 8, 2010 and the final joint public meeting held July 28, 2010;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Chatsworth Mayor and Council that the Report of Accomplishments, 2005-2010; the Implementation Schedule (Short Term Work Program) Update, 2011-2015; and the capacity assurance letter may be sent to the Northwest Georgia Regional Commission and the Department of Community Affairs for review and approval.
